Bydd rhaglen arbennig - **Goreuon Ryan a Ronnie** - ar S4C ar Ddydd Calan yn dathlu ac edrych yn ôl ar hanes Ryan Davies a Ronnie Williams a hefyd yn ceisio darganfod pam yr oeddent mor boblogaidd.

Trwy ddadansoddi talentau'r ddau - doniau sgriptio ac actio Ronnie a thalentau comedi a cherddorol Ryan - mae'r rhaglen yn cynnig golwg ffres ar y ddeuawd chwedlonol.

Cawn ein hatgoffa hefyd bod Ryan a Ronnie yn gantorion talentog. Bydd cyfle i fwynhau ac ail-fyw perfformiadau o glasuron megis *Yn y Bore*, *Blodwen a Meri* a *Pan fo'r Nos yn Hir* sy'n dod a gwên i'r wyneb ac ambell i ddeigrin i'r llygad.

Y digrifwr Tudur Owen sy'n cyflwyno'r rhaglen ond clywn hefyd gan sêr byd adloniant Cymru am eu hatgofion o'r ddeuawd, eu barn nhw am y rheswm tu ôl i lwyddiant Ryan a Ronnie a pham rydym ni dal yn eu trysori heddiw.

Tudur Owen: "Roedd Ryan a Ronnie yr un mor boblogaidd yn y de ac yn y gogledd, ymysg Cymry Cymraeg a'r di-gymraeg ac yn agos at galonnau pob cenhedlaeth."

Margaret Williams, y gantores a pherfformiwr rheolaidd ar sioe Ryan a Ronnie: "Mi oedan nhw'n unigryw iawn - yn enwedig yn y cyfnod yna pan doedd 'na ddim sôn am ddeuawd ddigri. Ddaru pawb gymryd at Ryan a Ronnie achos mi oeddau nhw yn wahanol, oeddau nhw yn broffesiynol, oeddau nhw yn ddigri - oeddau nhw yn Gymreig."

Gillian Elisa, Actores a chantores: "O'n nhw'n dod allan o'r sgrin, o'n nhw'n gwybod sut i gyfathrebu gyda'r gynulleidfa. O'ch chi'n teimlo eich bod chi'n eu 'nabod nhw ac yn perthyn iddyn nhw."

Aled Pugh, digrifwr ac actor. Wnaeth Aled bortreadu Ryan yn y ffilm 2009 *Ryan a Ronnie*: "Gan fod Ryan a Ronnie yn nabod y gynulleidfa, oeddau nhw'n mynnu eu bod nhw yn eu defnyddio nhw. Felly, oedd pobl yn gwybod eu bod nhw ddim jysd yn mynd i weld Ryan a Ronnie ond o'n nhw mynd i fod yn rhan o sioe Ryan a Ronnie - ac roedd hynna'n creu cyffro mawr."

Tudur Owen: "Ryan and Ronnie were just as popular in the south as they were in the north, among Welsh and non-Welsh speakers and close to the hearts of people of all ages."

Margaret Williams, singer and regular performer on the Ryan and Ronnie show: "They were completely unique – especially at a time when there wasn't really anything else of its kind. Everybody loved Ryan and Ronnie because they were different, they were professional, they were funny, they were Welsh."

Gillian Elisa, actor and singer: "They just jumped out of the screen – they knew how to communicate with their audience. You felt as if you knew them and were related to them."

Aled Pugh, actor and comedian. Aled portrayed Ryan in the 2009 film *Ryan a Ronnie*: "Because Ryan and Ronnie knew their audience, they were determined to use them. So, people knew they weren't just going to see *Ryan a Ronnie*, they were going to be a part of the Ryan and Ronnie show – and this created huge excitement."

So, come and enjoy an hour of sketches and unique comedy by Ryan and Ronnie side by side with the memories and impressions of some of Wales's top stars.
