Yn y rhaglen hon, rydym ym Mrynaman, pentref wrth droed y Mynydd Du ar gyfer yr **Hewlfa Drysor**. Mae'r cwrs cylch yma yn 24 milltir o hyd ac mi ddylai'r hewlfa gymryd tuag awr i'w gwblhau. 3 car, 3 tîm a £500 - pwy fydd yn cipio'r wobr y tro yma?

Y timau sy'n tarfu ar lonyddwch Brynaman y tro hwn yw Tîm Buddies Barry Road sef dau gwpwl sy'n byw ar yr un stryd, Tîm y Cigyddion Direidus, y teulu brwdfrydig a chystadleuol, a Thîm Coco, teulu ifanc sydd wedi'i enwi eu tîm ar ôl eu ci bach!

Bydd pob tîm mewn car, gyda chamerâu ym mhob ongl a chamerâu 360 gradd ar ben y ceir, sy'n dal popeth, "a dwi'n meddwl popeth" yn ôl y Welsh Whisperer!

Mae cwestiynau'r hewlfa i fod i yrru'r teithwyr i'r cyfeiriad cywir, ond bydd angen llygaid barcud ar yr un pryd er mwyn peidio â methu ambell i drysor ar hyd y ffordd.

Mae'r cwmpo mas rhwng y seddi blaen a'r cefn yn rhywbeth mae pawb wedi profi rhywbryd yn eu bywydau rwy'n siŵr."

Roedd hefyd yn brofiad gwych cael teithio Cymru a chyfarfod pobl ddiddorol o bob ardal:

There's fun to be had in a treasure trail!

What do you get when you mix three cars of talkative people, a series of questions, chances to win treasures and Lisa Angharad and the Welsh Whisperer? Yes, a new series of **Hewlfa Drysor** (Treasure Trail)!

We travel the lanes of Wales and learn a bit of local history as a group of competitors try to complete the **Hewlfa Drysor**.

With Lisa Angharad and the Welsh Whisperer presenting, there's plenty of fun to be had as we get to know Wales better with a bunch of competitive residents.

Both presenters have been busy devising specific questions for each area that will surely cause plenty of controversy along the way. As well as answering questions, treasures on the trail will offer competitors the opportunity to earn bonus points.

The Welsh Whisperer said:

"This series is unique because the treasure hunters don't have a script, they get their questions and then have to complete the course by answering the questions correctly...but that's easier said than done!

"It's particularly interesting for viewers who know the areas because I'm sure many will know the answers better than some of the teams and will be shouting at the TV, which is always good!"

In this programme, we are in Brynaman, a village at the foot of the Black Mountains, for the treasure trail. This circular course is 24 miles long and should take about an hour to complete. Three cars, three teams and £500 - who will win the prize?

The teams that are disturbing the tranquillity of Brynaman this time are the Barry Road Buddies Team, two couples who live on the same street, the Mischievous Butchers Team, a keen and competitive family and Team Coco, a young family with a team named after their dog!

All teams will be in a car, with cameras at every angle and 360-degree cameras on top of the cars, which capture everything, "and I mean everything" according to the Welsh Whisperer!

The trail's questions are supposed to drive the passengers in the right direction, but at the same time they will need to keep a look out for some treasures along the way.



But it's not just local knowledge that's needed in this unique trail - there are also opportunities around the course to gain vital treasures. Competitors need to race a wheelbarrow full of water around a track without the water going under the white line, answer a question from Shane Williams on the rugby pitch, lead a small silver ball from one corner of a table to the other without it falling through the holes and try to perform a special dance from Russia!

According to the Welsh Whisperer, his highlight in every programme is seeing teams "missing obvious answers and sometimes traveling miles away from the course, but thinking they were right! The falling out between the front and back seats is something everyone has probably experienced at some point in their lives."

It was also a great experience travelling Wales and meeting interesting people from all areas:

"It is always a pleasure to go to different areas and to see the competitors' understanding of their own areas, and I've learned a great deal myself!"

This is an opportunity for the whole family to join in the trail at home and test your knowledge of different parts of Wales while enjoying spectacular scenery, learning new things along the way and see some familiar faces, too.

The series also travels to Llangernyw and the first programmes in the series Chwilog, Llanerfyl and Llangrannog, are available on demand.
